Bots, Blogs and News Aggregators (<http://www.BotsBlogs.com/>) is a keynote presentation that I have been delivering over the last several years, and much of my information comes from the extensive research that I have completed over the years into the “invisible” or what I like to call the “deep” web. The Deep Web covers somewhere in the vicinity of 1 trillion plus pages of information located through the world wide web in various files and formats that the current search engines on the Internet either cannot find or have difficulty accessing. The current search engines find hundreds of billions of pages at the present time of this writing.

In the last several years, some of the more comprehensive search engines have written algorithms to search the deeper portions of the world wide web by attempting to find files such as .pdf, .doc, .xls, ppt, .ps. and others. These files are predominately used by businesses to communicate their information within their organization or to disseminate information to the external world from their organization. Searching for this information using deeper search techniques and the latest algorithms allows researchers to obtain a vast amount of corporate information that was previously unavailable or inaccessible. Research has also shown that even deeper information can be obtained from these files by searching and accessing the “properties” information on these files!

You may also press the enter key instead. After searching for a word, the main display will populate with many words and meanings. The word you searched for will appear in the center of the display, and will be surrounded with words and meanings that are related to it. To save what is currently displayed in the Graph Words, you can press the "Save as image" button on the toolbar. Underneath Graph Words lays the WordNet - a large lexical database of English. Nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs are grouped into sets of cognitive synonyms (synsets), each expressing a distinct concept. These meanings and semantic relationships are revealed graphically by the HTML5 canvas made available by Graph Words. Recent improvements in sequencing technology ("next-gen" sequencing platforms) have sharply reduced the cost of sequencing. The 1000 Genomes Project is the first project to sequence the genomes of a large number of people, to provide a comprehensive resource on human genetic variation. As with other major human genome reference projects, data from the 1000 Genomes Project will be made available quickly to the worldwide scientific community through freely accessible public databases. The goal of the 1000 Genomes Project is to find most genetic variants that have frequencies of at least 1% in the populations studied. This goal can be attained by sequencing many individuals lightly. To sequence a person's genome, many copies of the DNA are broken into short pieces and each piece is sequenced. The many copies of DNA mean that the DNA pieces are more-or-less randomly distributed across the genome. The pieces are then aligned to the reference sequence and joined together. To find the complete genomic sequence of one person with current sequencing platforms requires sequencing that person's DNA the equivalent of about 28 times (called 28X). If the amount of sequence done is only an

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average of once across the genome (1X), then much of the sequence will be missed, because some genomic locations will be covered by several pieces while others will have none. The deeper the sequencing coverage, the more of the genome will be covered at least once. Also, people are diploid; the deeper the sequencing coverage, the more likely that both chromosomes at a location will be included. In addition, deeper coverage is particularly useful for detecting structural variants, and allows sequencing errors to be corrected. Sequencing is still too expensive to deeply sequence the many samples being studied for this project. However, any particular region of the genome generally contains a limited number of haplotypes. Data can be combined across many samples to allow efficient detection of most of the variants in a region. The Project currently plans to sequence each sample to about 4X coverage; at this depth sequencing cannot provide the complete genotype of each sample, but should allow the detection of most variants with frequencies as low as 1%. Combining the data from 2500 samples should allow highly accurate estimation (imputation) of the variants and genotypes for each sample that were not seen directly by the light sequencing. If the user selects a specific talk for detailed review, thumbnail images of all slides within that video are shown, and visual cues are displayed to indicate slides that contain one or more of the search terms. When the user locates a slide of interest, the video segment in which it appears may be directly accessed for playback by clicking on the corresponding slide thumbnail. The interface thus enables efficient content-based search and non-linear playback. TalkMiner builds its index and interface from commonly recorded video rather than using a custom designed lecture-capture system or requiring careful post-capture authoring. Moreover, the system does not impose onerous constraints on the captured video. TalkMiner's slide detection algorithm was developed to handle common lecture webcast video production techniques. Such production techniques include shooting a slide screen from the back of the room, picture-in-picture compositing, and multiple camera productions that intersperse full-frame shots of slides with shots of the speaker. Each of these cases present challenges to assembling a set of distinct and useful slide keyframes for browsing an individual lecture video. Additionally, we developed processing for slides with built up content that are revealed gradually (e.g., bullet lists). TalkMiner's specialized content analysis allows it to scale to include a greater volume and variety of content. At the same time, its minimal storage and processing requirements enable it to do so at a much lower cost than would otherwise be possible. 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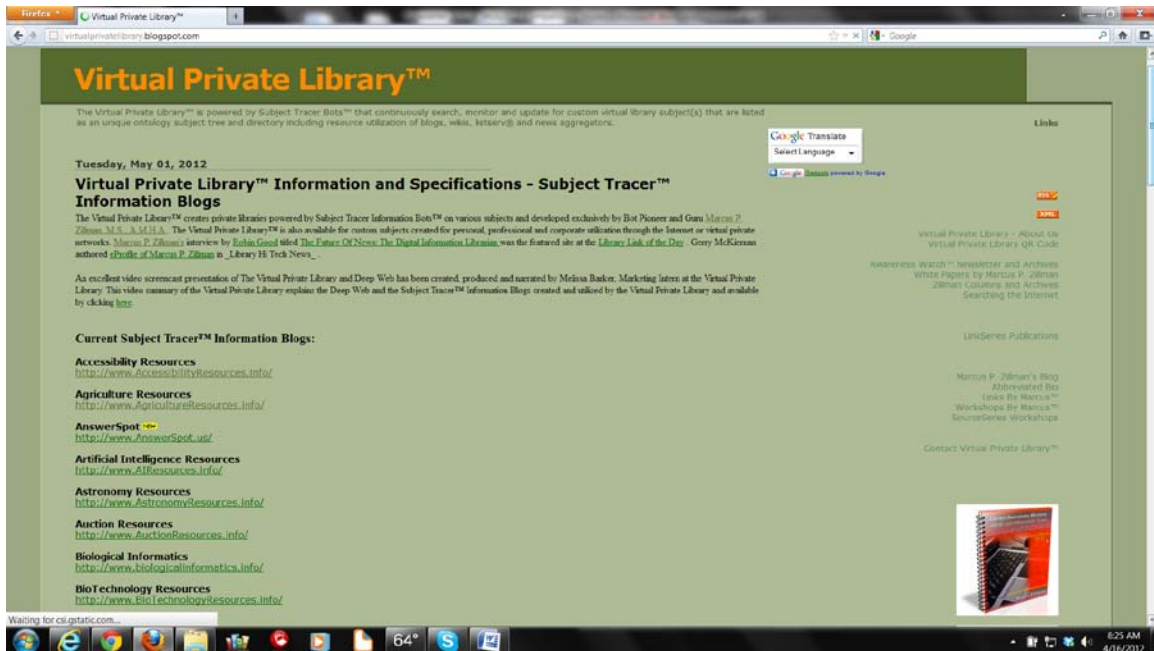


Figure 2: Virtual Private Library™
