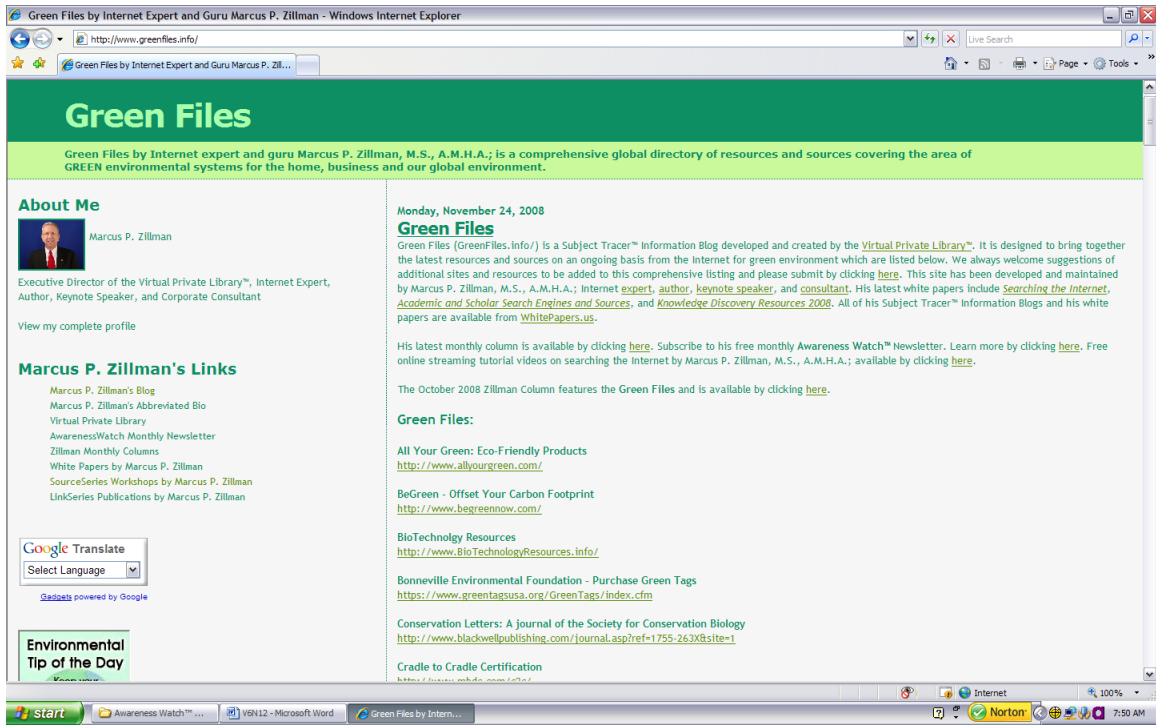


Figure 1: GreenFiles.info

### **Permanent Access to the Records of Science in Europe (PARSE)**

PARSE.Insight is a two-year project co-funded by the European Union under the Seventh Framework Programme. It is concerned with the preservation of digital information in science, from primary data through analysis to the final publications resulting from the research. The problem is how to safeguard this valuable digital material over time, to ensure that it is accessible, usable and understandable in future. The rapid pace of change in information technology threatens media, file formats and software with obsolescence, and changing concepts and terminology also mean that, even if data can be read, it might not be correctly interpreted by future generations. Many initiatives are already under way in this area, and the aim of the PARSE.Insight project is to develop a roadmap and recommendations for developing the e-infrastructure in order to maintain the long-term accessibility and usability of scientific digital information in Europe. The project will conduct surveys and in-depth case studies of different scientific disciplines and stakeholders and will base its results on these findings, as well as knowledge of ongoing developments. PARSE.Insight is closely linked to the Alliance for Permanent Access to the Records of Science. The output from the project is intended to guide the European Commission's strategy about research infrastructure. This has been added to [Academic](#)

### **Hong Kong University Theses Online**

The Hong Kong University Theses Collection holds 16,574 titles of theses and dissertations submitted for higher degrees to the University of Hong Kong since 1941. The first recorded thesis was dated 1928, though all theses prior to 1941 were lost during the occupation of WWII. HKUTO includes works in the arts, humanities, education and the social, medical and natural sciences. Many of them deal entirely with or focus on subjects relating to Hong Kong. The collection is primarily in English, with some in English and Chinese, and others in Chinese only. Almost all HKU theses are included in HKUTO. The software also allows multiple IMs to be handled by the same operator, allows operators to have private conversations amongst themselves, allows admins to monitor all active IMs, allows multiple operators to chat with the same user, and includes reporting features for measuring use statistics. Individual operator profiles allow operators to save pre-scripted messages for use in IM, and to provide a description of themselves, their contact information, and their area of specialty that can be seen by other operators. The world stands on the threshold of a demographic revolution with few parallels in humanity's past. It's called global aging, and in the coming decades it will subject nations around the world to extraordinary economic, social, and political challenges. CSIS established the Global Aging Initiative in 1999 to raise awareness of the scope and magnitude of these challenges and to encourage timely reform. Over the past nine years, GAI has pursued an ambitious educational agenda. They have organized more than half a dozen major international conferences—in Beijing, Berlin, Brussels, Paris, Seoul, Tokyo, Washington, and Zurich—that have brought together world leaders to discuss common problems and explore common solutions. For most of human history, until about a century ago, the elderly (people aged 65 and over) never amounted to more than 2 or 3 percent of the population. Today, in the developed world, they amount to 15 percent. By the year 2030, they will be around 25 percent. As recently as 1980, the median age of the oldest society on earth (Sweden) was 36. By the year 2030, the median age of the entire developed world is projected to be 45. In Japan and much of southern and eastern Europe, it will be over 50. As a whole, the developing world will remain much younger for the foreseeable future. Yet it too is aging—hence the term "global aging." Several major countries in East Asia and Latin America, including China, South Korea, and Mexico are projected to reach developed-world levels of old-age dependency by the middle of the century. The most predictable challenge posed by global aging is the mounting fiscal burden. Over the next thirty years, GAI projects that the rising cost of pay-as-you-go pensions and health-care benefits to the elderly is on track to push up government outlays by roughly 10 percent of GDP on average in the developed countries—the equivalent of an extra 25 percent of worker payroll on top of payroll tax rates that often exceed 25 percent already. Increasingly, governments will face the choice between economically ruinous tax hikes and politically impossible benefit cuts—or else be compelled to run widening fiscal deficits that undermine national savings and economic growth. ### **Abstract:**

How do people use the internet to solve problems? Employing quantitative and qualitative data from two surveys, one in which a random selection of the U.S population responded and one in which a self-selected group of people responded, we argue that individuals use different sources and channels to seek information and assistance, depending on the problem they face. We find that a significant portion of online Americans turn to the internet at times because it seems to fulfill their needs more readily and thoroughly than the people in their community network do. We present evidence of when people use the internet versus seeking the assistance of friends and family and possible reasons for this behavior. This research demonstrates how, to what extent, when and why the internet supplements people's lives.

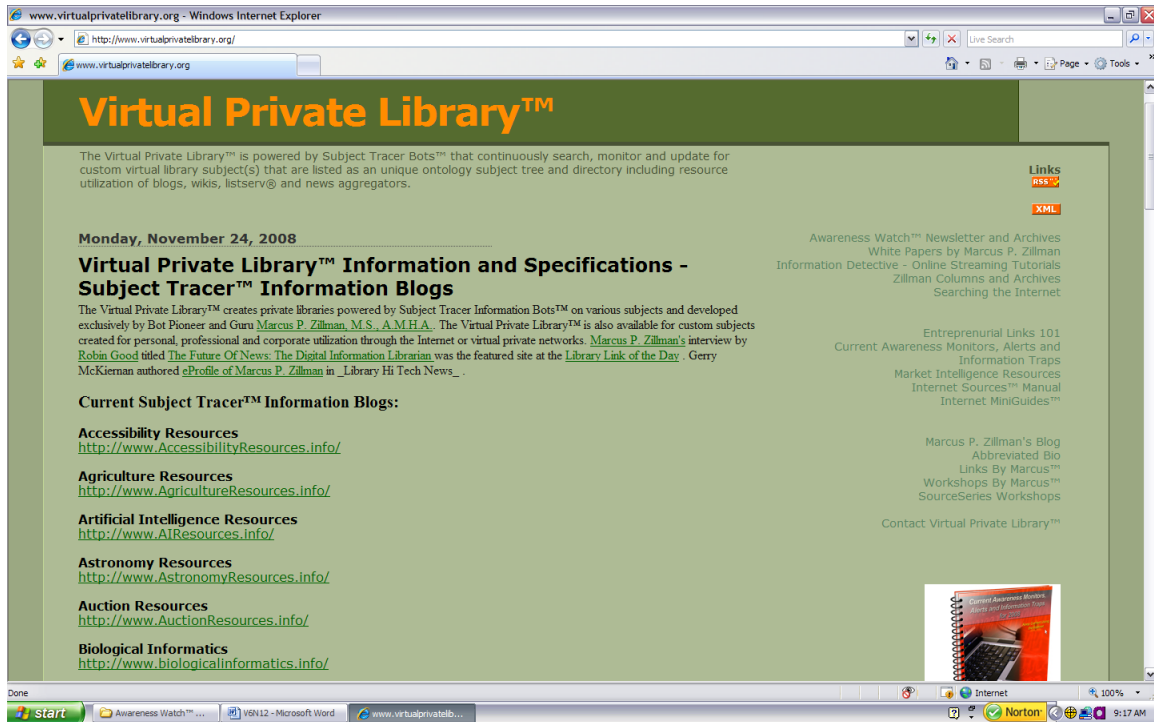


Figure 2: VirtualPrivateLibrary.org
