Once you state your privacy preferences (low, medium, high, or custom), the search results are ordered based on how their computer-readable privacy policies comply with your preferences. A privacy meter with four green boxes indicates that the website complies with all your privacy preferences. Websites that do not comply with some or all of your preferences will have privacy meters with fewer than four green boxes. The number of green boxes that are missing are proportional to the number of preference conflicts between the website's privacy policy and your privacy preferences. The absence of the privacy meter means that a valid computer-readable privacy policy, known as a P3P policy, could not be located. The Pew Internet Project's latest report, "Digital Footprints," finds that 47% of internet users have searched for their own name online, up from 22% five years ago. Yet, even as internet users are becoming more aware of their digital footprint, few monitor their online presence with great regularity. Just 3% of self-searchers report that they make a regular habit of it and 74% have checked up on their digital footprints only once or twice. Indeed, most internet users say they are not concerned about the amount of information available about them online, and most do not take steps to limit that information. Fully 60% of internet users say they are not worried about how much information is available about them online. Similarly, the majority of online adults (61%) do not feel compelled to limit the amount of information that can be found about them online. The scientific objective of the CEN is to understand extreme environments and how they respond to global change related to human activities. Research is conducted at high latitudes (polar regions), at high altitude (alpine environments), and in other environments affected by seasonal climatic constraints (such as cold winters). The CEN is also an academic centre where students are trained to analyze ecological processes and to assess environmental impacts especially in cold regions. The CEN's members include approximately thirty researchers (regular and associate members), fifteen collaborators, more than one hundred graduate students and twenty employees. Écoscience is a multidisciplinary journal that stems from the need to create a forum for all ecologists. Écoscience publishes original work focusing on patterns and processes at various temporal and spatial scales and at different levels of biological organization. Écoscience welcomes work in evolutionary and behavioral ecology, ecophysiology, population and community ecology, landscape and ecosystem ecology, numerical ecology, dendroecology and, paleoecology.

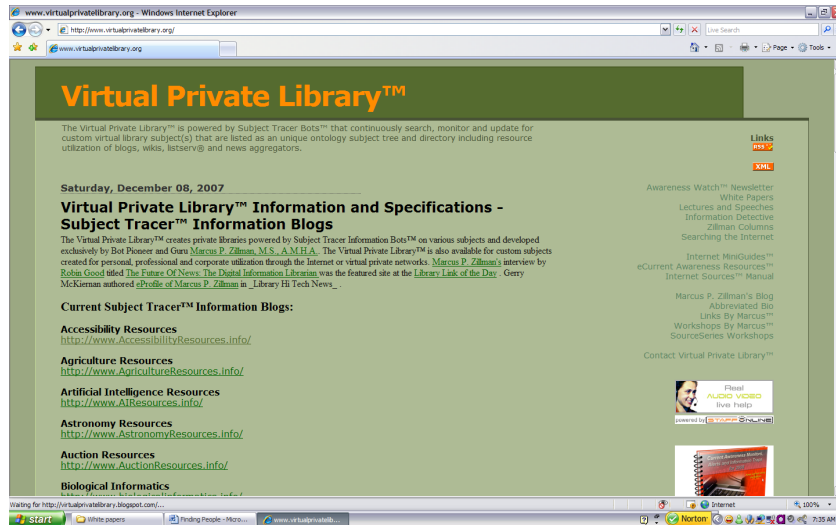


Figure 2: Virtual Private Library™
