The client then uses strong cryptographic mechanisms to not only encrypt the location data, but also ensure that the ciphertexts stored within OpenDHT are anonymous and unlinkable. Secondly, it aims to use new and rapidly moving developments in information technology and electronic communication to provide an order of magnitude increase in the facilities available for research and training in this area through provision of a powerful computational grid. The two aims mutually reinforce each other, the computational grid mirroring and supporting the intellectual and sociological network linking the participants. 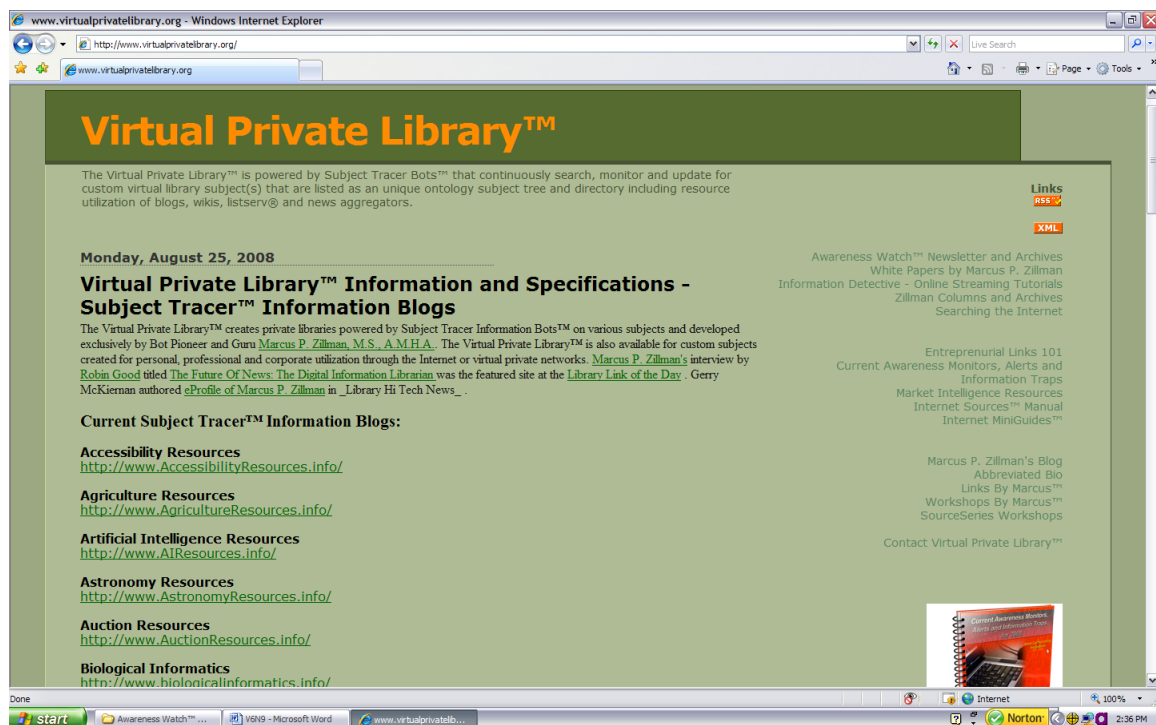


Figure 1: Virtual Private Library™
