Askmarkets is an internet-based service for prediction markets, which consists of virtual marketplaces for information trading. Their inspiration for askmarkets stems from several years of research on the topic of prediction markets, enabling them to separate the wheat from the chaff. The concept, at its very core, goes like this. Markets are institutions that are everywhere. From the stock market in New York to the fish market in Tokyo to the flower market in Amsterdam, markets exist and are used for a variety of purposes. But, while stock markets, for example, seem to be so different than betting, or fish and flower markets, in their core all those institutions are essentially the same: Markets bring people together, they sum up their information and transmit it through prices. Askmarkets intends to bring this functionality to the masses. They provide a tool with which anyone can create a virtual market or trade in markets created by others. In other words, they provide a tool which can aggregate the opinions and knowledge of the many and transform these into a meaningful result. Markets arise as the ideal tool to crowdsource cognitive tasks and arrive at consensus results which are typically proven to be more accurate or correct than the opinions of the few experts, as suggested by both theory, experiments and practice. Current Law Journal Content provides: a) Displays all the tables of contents for issues added during a user selected date range; b) Searches for words in article citations (author/title/abstract/journal-name fields); c) Links to tables of contents for any one of the 1425 individual law journals; d) Links via an openURL server from authored article citations to corresponding retrieval possibilities in Lexis, Westlaw, BEPress, SSRN and other full-text databases (passwords may be required); and e) Supplies RSS feeds of contents for all, selected, or individual law journals, and also for the results of word searches. The table of contents information is obtained from a number of sources: 1) TOCs of 571 journals are obtained electronically at Washington and Lee via e-mail, web-sites, or RSS feeds; 2) TOCs of 90 journals are OCR scanned from paper copy at Washington and Lee; 3) TOCs of 718 journals are OCR scanned from paper copy at the University of Texas Tarlton Law Library and are incorporated into this service with the kind permission of the Tarlton Law Library; and 4) TOCs of 46 journals are scanned from paper copy at other libraries. GoodRelations Vocabulary - Semantic Web Based eCommerce

A promising application domain for Semantic Web technology is the annotation of products and services offerings on the Web so that consumers and enterprises can search for suitable suppliers using products and services ontologies. While there has been substantial progress in developing ontologies for types of products and services, namely eClassOWL, this alone does not provide the representational means required for e-commerce on the Semantic Web. Particularly missing is an ontology that allows describing the relationships between (1) Web resources, (2) offerings made by means of those Web resources, (3) legal entities, (4) prices, (5) terms and conditions, and (6) the aforementioned ontologies for products and services. GoodRelations is a lightweight ontology for annotating offerings on the Web. It is to their knowledge the first non-toy vocabulary for describing the types of goods and terms and conditions of items and services offered on the Web. The GoodRelations ontology complements products and services ontologies, like eClassOWL, by providing the vocabulary for expressing things like: a) that a particular Web site describes an offer to sell cellphones of a certain make

The U.S. Census Bureau released the new Statistical Abstract of the United States: 2009. First published in 1878, “Uncle Sam’s Almanac” is a summary of statistics on a wide range of important topics, from A (aquaculture) to Z (zinc production). Whether one seeks numbers on biofuel or banking, foreign trade or foreign aid, cars or bars, there is no better one-stop shop for statistics. For example, the average length of stay for patients at community hospitals declined from 7.2 days in 1990 to 5.5 days in 2006. Yet over the same period, the average cost per patient stay climbed 81 percent, from \$4,947 to \$8,970. Also, Americans are spending more on retail prescription drugs. Drug sales climbed from \$72.2 billion in 1995 to \$259.4 billion in 2007, with the majority of spending shifting from brand name to generic (60 percent brand name in 1995, less than 42 percent in 2007). The 128th edition contains more than 1,400 tables of social, political and

Computer-mediated Communication in Low- and High-Context Cultures by Jan Pflug

Abstract:

The purpose of this study is to assess the applicability of Hall's cultural dimension of contextuality to computer-mediated communication (CMC) in Internet forums. Despite initial attempts to understand the interplay between contextuality and CMC, the range of researched communication scenarios has been rather limited. In particular, new communication media in the form of Internet forums largely have been neglected. To fill this void, a content analysis of 376 postings from German (a low-context culture) and Indian (a high-context culture) internet forums was conducted. The results partially validate the explanatory power of contextuality. Congruent with Hall's cultural perspective, it was found that Indians disclose less private information in online discussions than Germans. Furthermore, Indians used more emoticons than their German counterparts, reflecting the higher importance of nonverbal communication in high-context cultures. Limitations of the study and directions for future research are also discussed.

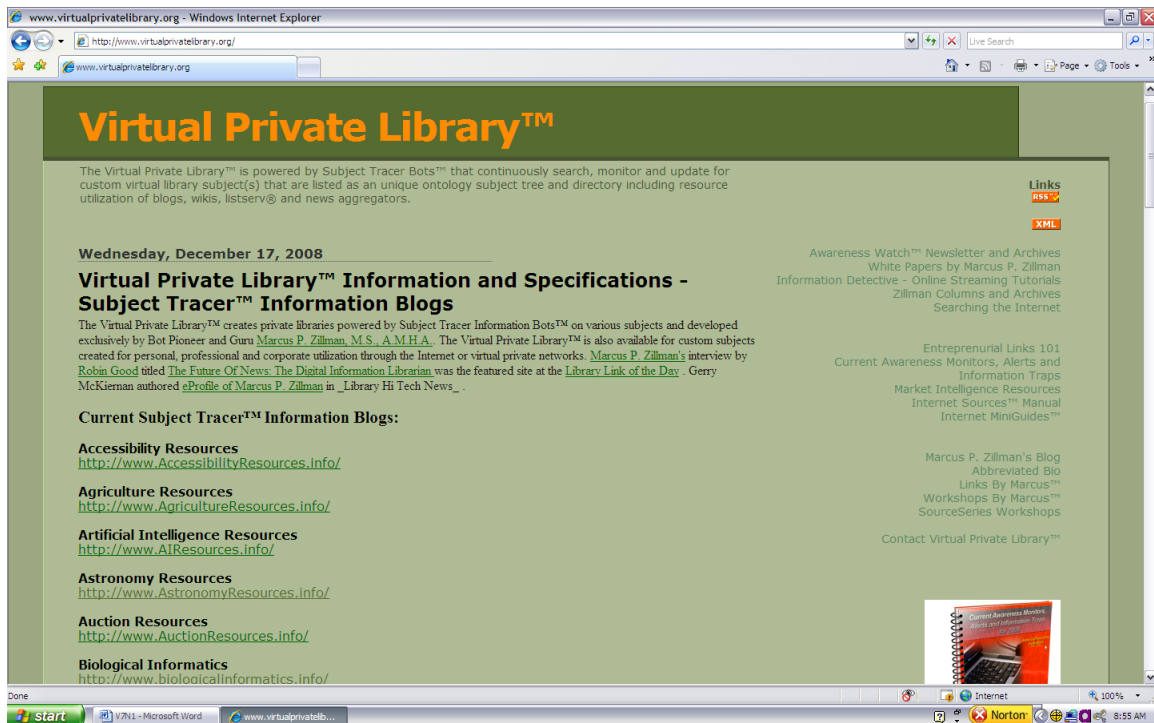


Figure 2: VirtualPrivateLibrary.org
