Bots, Blogs and News Aggregators (<http://www.zillman.tv/>) is a keynote presentation that I have been delivering over the last several years, and much of my information comes from the extensive research that I have completed over the years into the “invisible” or what I like to call the “deep” web. The Deep Web covers somewhere in the vicinity of 1 trillion pages of information located through the world wide web in various files and formats that the current search engines on the Internet either cannot find or have difficulty accessing. The current search engines find about 20 billion pages at the present time of this writing.

In the last several years, some of the more comprehensive search engines have written algorithms to search the deeper portions of the world wide web by attempting to find files such as .pdf, .doc, .xls, ppt, .ps. and others. These files are predominately used by businesses to communicate their information within their organization or to disseminate information to the external world from their organization. Searching for this information using deeper search techniques and the latest algorithms allows researchers to obtain a vast amount of corporate information that was previously unavailable or inaccessible. Research has also shown that even deeper information can be obtained from these files by searching and accessing the “properties” information on these files!

This article and guide is designed to give you the resources you need to better understand the history of the deep web research, as well as various classified resources that allow you to search through the currently available web to find those key sources of information nuggets only found by understanding how to search the “deep web”.

may occur in the future. As the number of documents to examine rises, it becomes more and more challenging for analysts to uncover the embedded plans. They are creating Jigsaw, a visual analytics system to help analysts better assess, analyze, and make sense of such document collections. Their specific objective is to help analysts reach more timely and accurate understandings of the plot(s) embedded throughout textual reports. Jigsaw provides a collection of visualizations that each portray different aspects of the documents. They particularly focus on presenting the identifiable important entities (people, places, organizations, etc.) and their direct or indirect connections. Textual processing extracts the important entities from the documents and then the visualizations help an analyst to explore the relationships and connections among the entities. The system includes graph, calendar, scatterplot and and tabular connections-based views, as well as views of individual document's text and the report collections as a whole. Jigsaw essentially acts as a visual index onto the document collection, helping analysts identify particular documents to read and examine next. Deezer has been highly successful due to its innovative offering and philosophy, which was widely hailed by the press. Less than two months after its launch, Deezer announced the acquisition of the catalogues of leading major and independent record companies: Sony BMG, Because Music, Believe On 14 May 2008, the website announced the signing of an international agreement with the giant Universal Music. The adventure continues, as the number of Deezer users increases with every passing day. In order to develop the offering more rapidly and implement its development strategy, the website decided to launch its own community network and expand its universe. The main principle of MapTube is that shared maps can be overlaid to compare data visually. For example, to see a map of the London Underground overlaid on top of a map of population, go to the search page and enter the keywords "tube" and "population". Then click on the two relevant maps to add them. They will be displayed when you click on "View". Maps can be viewed by everybody without logging in, but to create a map requires an account and a username. This ensures that only the owner of a map can edit its details. The maps themselves are not stored on the server, but only a link to another site on the Internet where the map is already published. When maps are shared, information about what the map is and what it shows is entered by the owner and this is stored on the server along with the link to where the map is published. The raw data is never stored on the Internet as the maps comprise the pre-rendered tiles made by the GMapCreator, so this is a safe way of sharing a map without giving away the raw data used to create it. MapTube is a product of the work undertaken by the Geographic Virtual Urban Environments (GeoVUE) team based at University College London's Centre for Advanced Spatial Analysis (CASA). 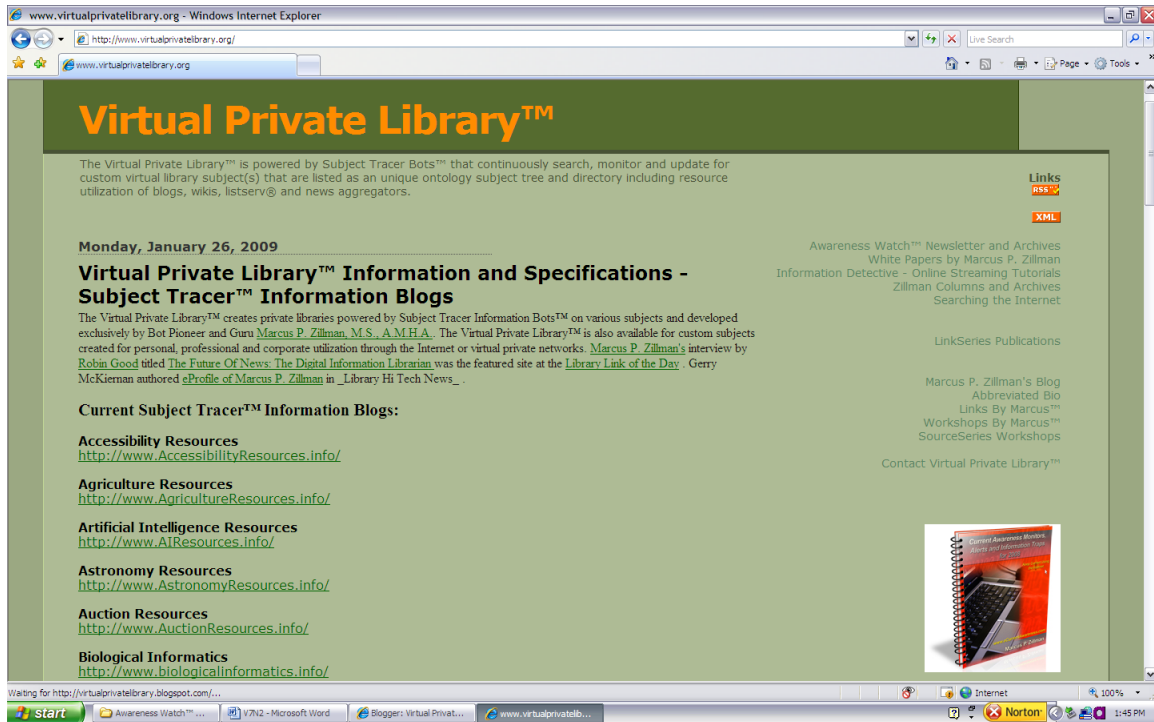


Figure 2: VirtualPrivateLibrary.org
