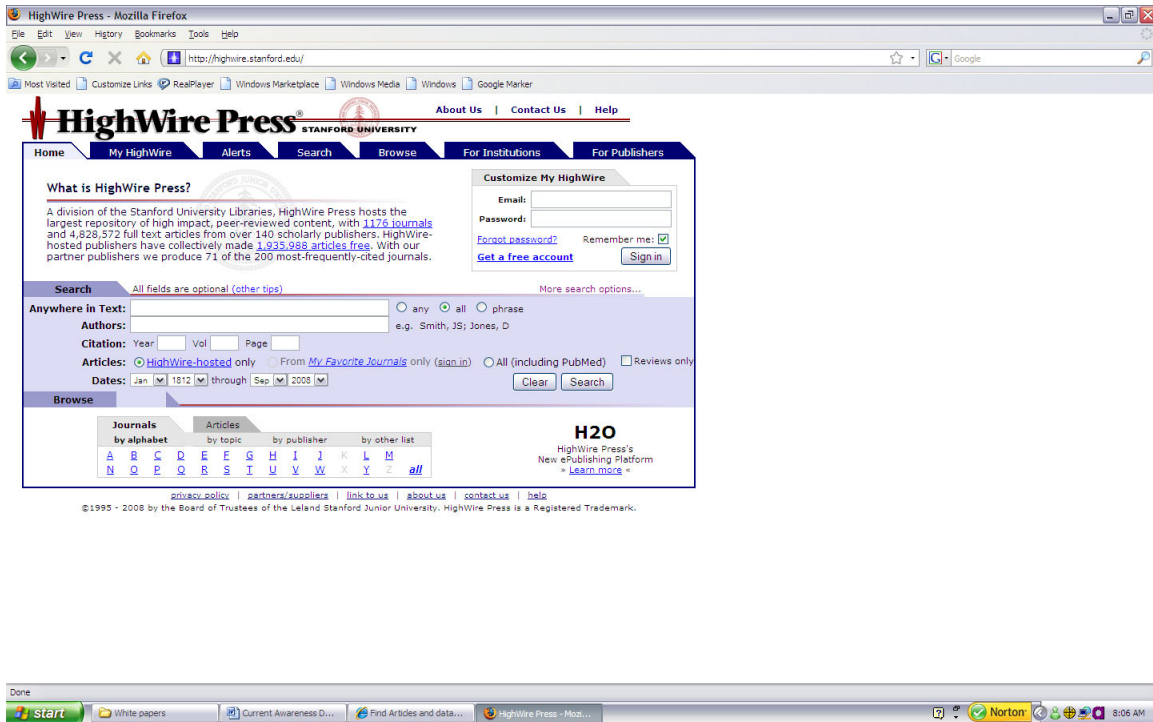


Figure 1: HighWire Web Site

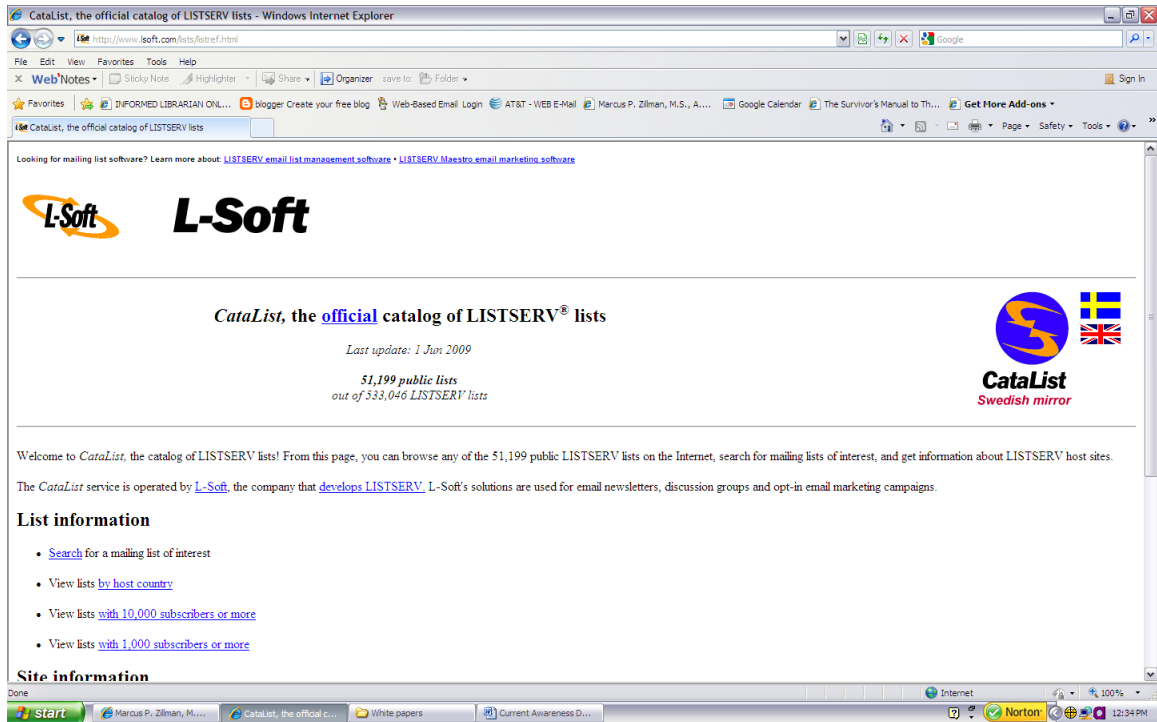


Figure 2: Catalist – Official Catalog of Listserv® Lists

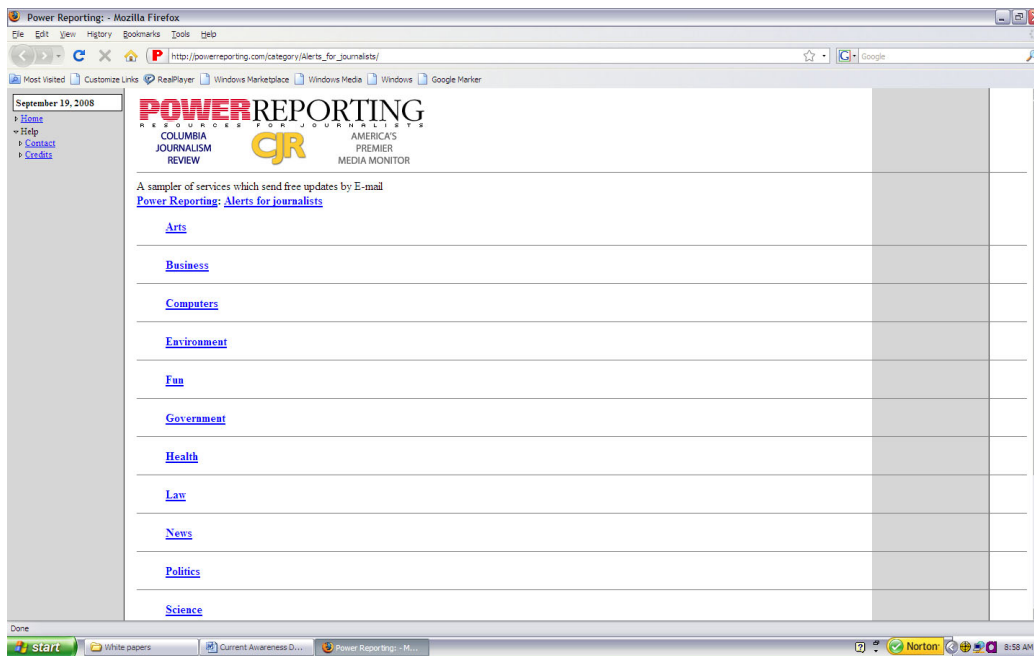


Figure 4: Power Reporting Alerts for Journalists

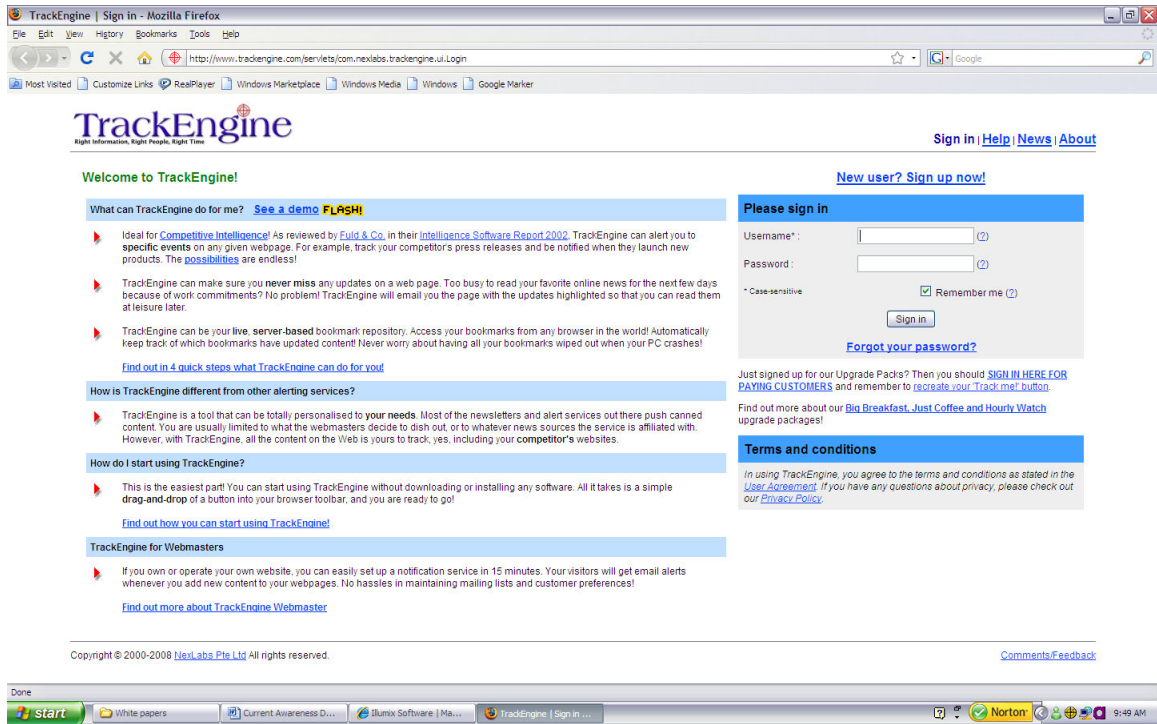


Figure 5: TrackEngine

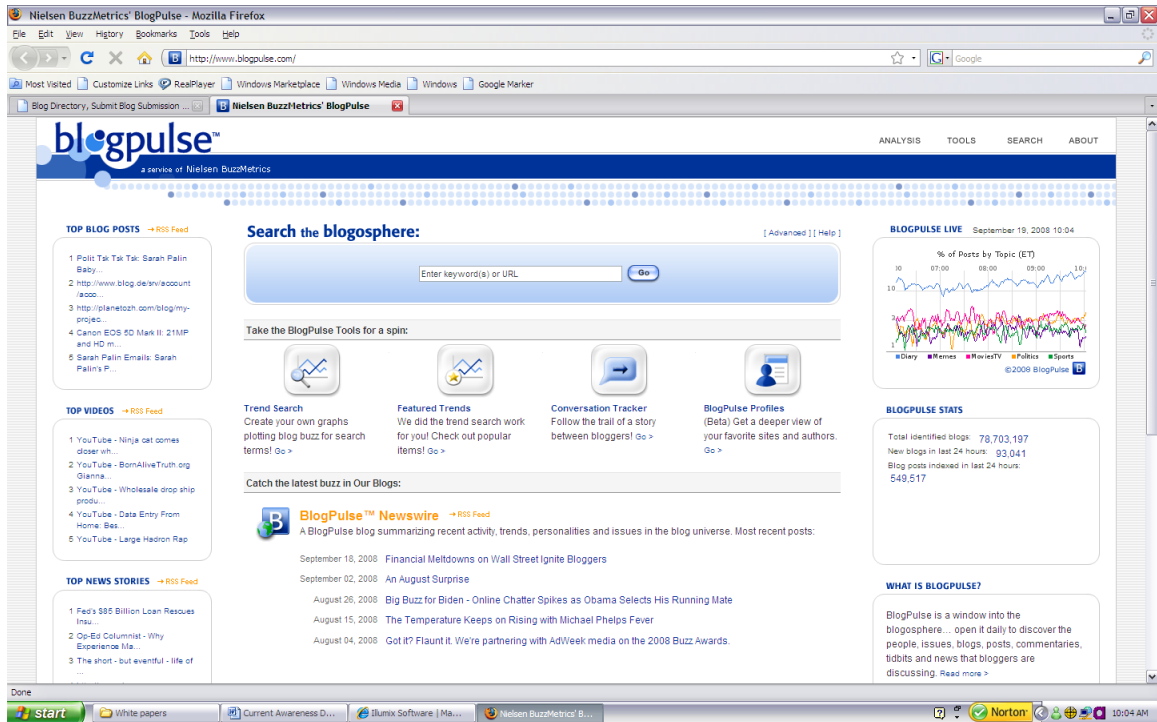


Figure 6: BlogPulse™

NEWS AGGREGATORS AND RSS FEEDS

News aggregators and the related RSS News Feeds are the backbone of WebLogs (Blogs) ability to disseminate the ongoing current awareness information to the Internet global community. Aggregating the key blogs that you are monitoring for current awareness and updates can now be created either by installed browser software called News Aggregators or you may use some of the brand new web applications that require no software installation on your computer. The latest News Aggregators read the RSS news feeds and can be updated by a click of a button or you may preprogram the news aggregator to update in certain time frames. The latest News Aggregators feature “auto-discovery” that allows the news aggregator to automatically discover the related RSS feed associated with the blog that you subscribe to. My news aggregator currently monitors and updates over 200 RSS newsfeeds every 15 minutes that allows me to keep current with all blogs that I monitor for updates and current happenings.

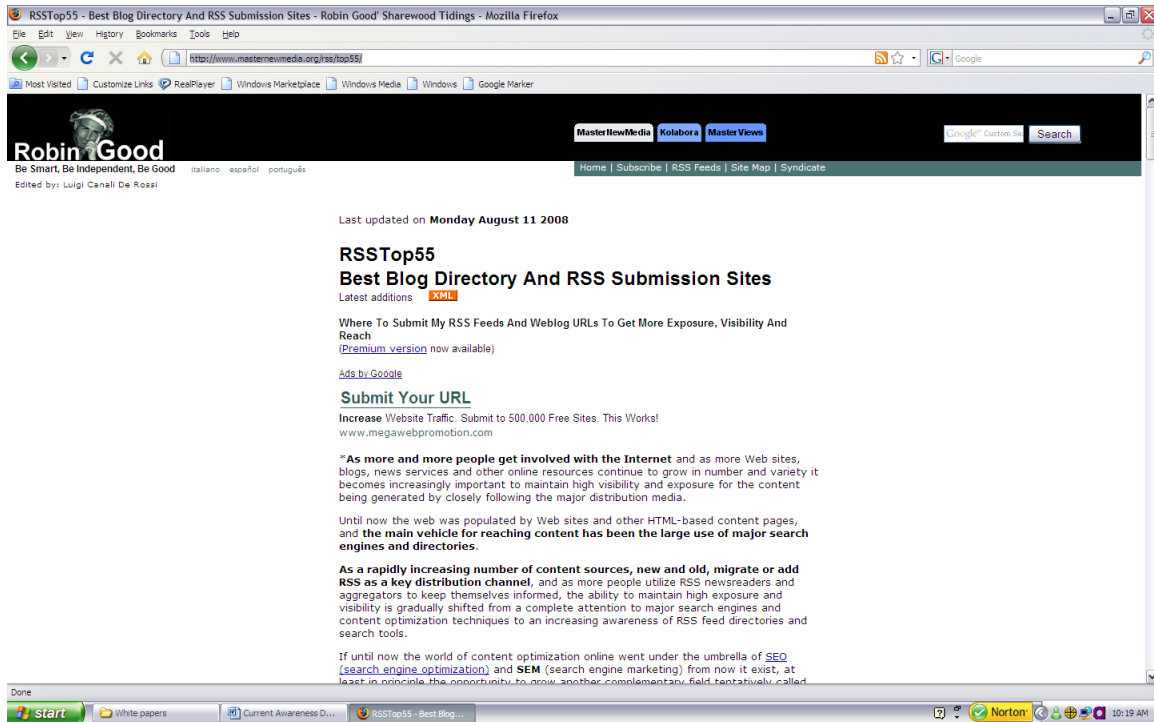


Figure 7: RSSTop55

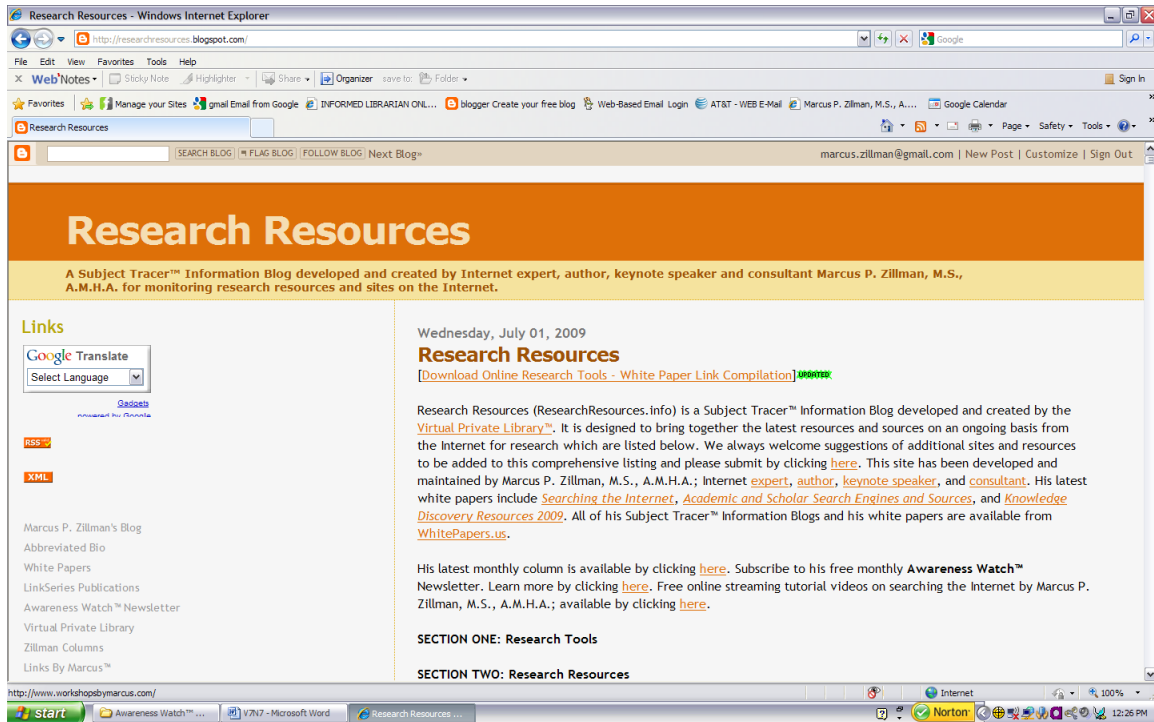


Figure 8: Research Resources Subject Tracer™ Information Blog

The Open Knowledge Definition (OKD) provides an answer to the question: what is open knowledge? It puts forward, in a simple and clear manner, principles that define open knowledge and which open knowledge licenses must satisfy. The concept of openness has already started to spread rapidly beyond its original roots in academia and software. They already have 'open access' journals, open genetics, open geodata, open content etc. As the concept spreads so they are seeing a proliferation of licenses and a potential blurring of what is open and what is not. In such circumstances it is important to preserve compatibility, guard against dilution of the concept, and provide a common thread to this multitude of activities across a variety of disciplines. The definition, by providing clear set of criteria for openness, is an essential tool in achieving these ends. The first version of the Open Knowledge Definition was developed by the Open Knowledge Foundation with substantial input from other interested parties. The project now has its own Advisory Council who oversee the development of the definition and associated materials. However as detailed on the participate page the project is community-based and anyone can participate. Individuals and organizations who would be interested in becoming members of the 'Advisory Council' and help 'curate' the definition over the longer-term are especially welcome. ODLIS is designed as a hypertext reference resource for library and information science professionals, university students and faculty, and users of all types of libraries. The primary criterion for including a term is whether a librarian or other information professional might reasonably be expected to know its meaning in the course of his or her work. A newly coined term is added when, in the author's judgment, it is likely to become a permanent addition to the lexicon of library and information science. The dictionary reflects North American practice; however, because ODLIS was first developed as an online resource available worldwide, with an e-mail contact address for feedback, users from many countries have contributed to its growth, often suggesting additional terms and commenting on existing definitions. Expansion of the dictionary is an ongoing process. Broad in scope, ODLIS includes not only the terminology of the various specializations within library science and information studies but also the vocabulary of publishing, printing, binding, the book trade, graphic arts, book history, literature, bibliography, telecommunications, and computer science when, in the author's judgment, a definition might prove helpful to librarians and information specialists in their work. Entries are descriptive, with examples provided when appropriate. The definitions of terms used in the Anglo-American Cataloging Rules follow AACR2 closely and are therefore intended to be prescriptive. The dictionary includes some slang terms and idioms and a few obsolete terms, often as See references to the term in current use. When the meaning of a term varies according to the field in which it is used, priority is given to the definition that applies within the field with which it is most closely associated. Definitions unrelated to library and information science are generally omitted. As a rule, definition is given under an acronym only when the full term is rarely used. Alphabetization is letter-by-letter. The authority for spelling and hyphenation is Webster's New World Dictionary of the American Language (College Edition). Universal Extractor is a program do to exactly what it says: extract files from any type of archive, whether it's a simple zip file, an installation program, or even a Windows Installer (.msi) package. This is still a work in progress (see details below), but so far it's proven quite useful and they feel others can also benefit from it. They should stress that this application is not intended to be a general purpose archiving program. It will never replace WinRAR, 7-Zip, etc. What it will do is allow you to extract files from virtually any type of archive, regardless of source, compression method, etc. The original motivation behind this project was that they wanted an easy, convenient way to extract files from installation packages, such as Inno Setup or Windows Installer packages, without pulling up a command line every time. In the process I got a little carried away and ended up throwing in support for every kind of archive format I possibly could find. Universal Extractor, like most of my Windows programs, is written in AutoIt, a powerful open source scripting language. 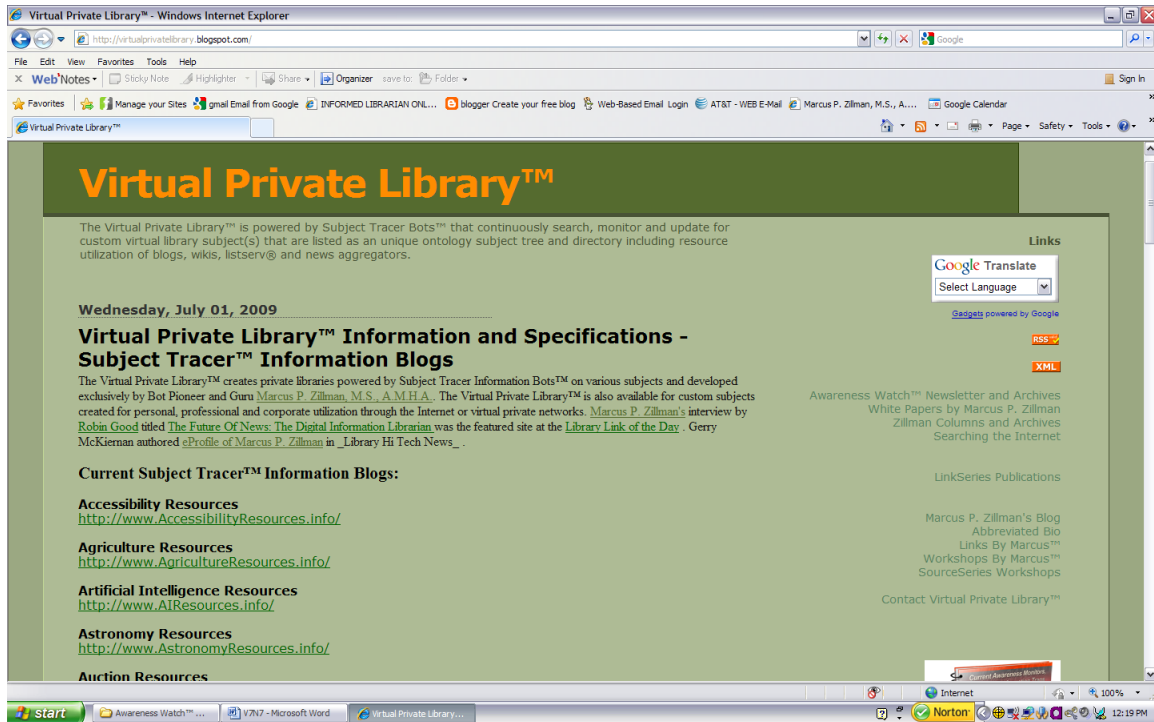


Figure 6: VirtualPrivateLibrary.org
