Experimental results show that the method outperforms the state of art methods in terms of crawling capability and breaks through the assumption of full-text search implied by existing methods. Guiding and promoting the grid technologies and their applications into health research and development are today HealthGrid's objective but the final goal would be actually to make successful the regular and worldwide use of healthgrids at the industrial level. 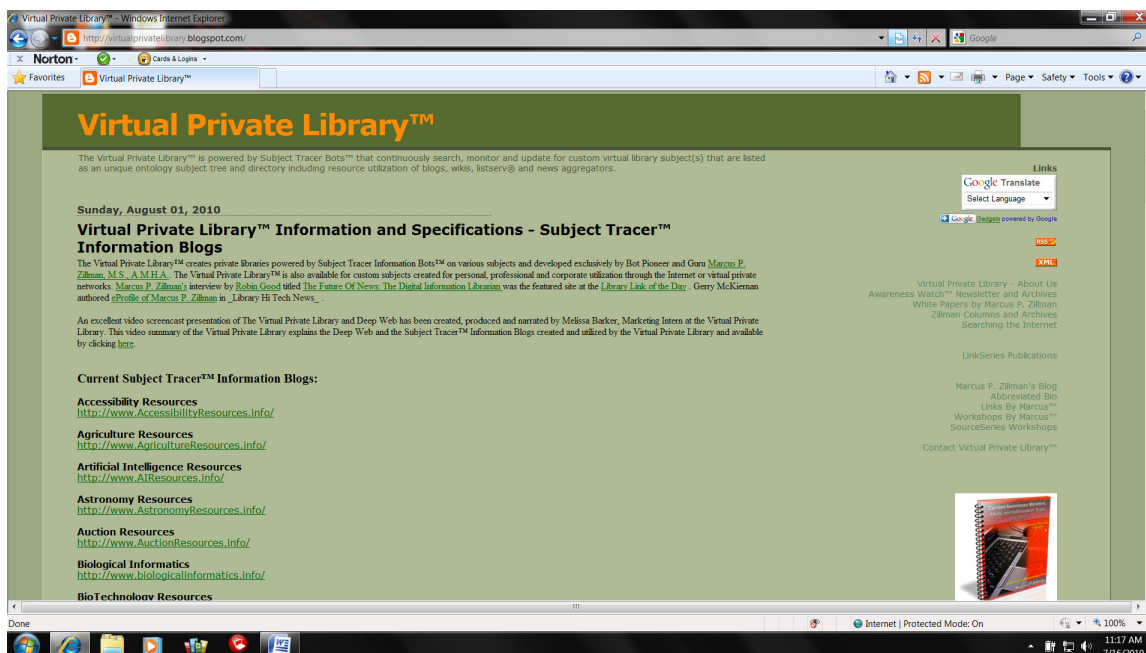


Figure 1: Virtual Private Library™
