They also include the supporting documents and other media issued and maintained by those bodies, such as dockets, hearings, forms, oral arguments, and legislative histories. These materials can be found in every branch, at every level, national, tribal, state and local, and

should be available to anyone with the will and the heart to obtain them. The following principles should govern the dissemination of primary legal materials in the United States: 1) Direct fees for dissemination of primary legal materials should be avoided; 2) Limitations on access through terms of use or the assertion of copyright on primary legal materials is contrary to long-standing public policy and core democratic principles and is misleading to citizens; 3) Primary legal materials should be made available using bulk access mechanisms so they may be downloaded by anyone; 4) The primary legal materials, and the methods used to access them, should be authenticated so people can trust in the integrity of these materials; 5) Historical archives should be made available online and in a static location to the extent possible; 6) Vendor- and media-neutral citation mechanisms should be employed; 7) Technical standards for document structure, identifiers, and metadata should be developed and applied as extensively as possible; 8) Data should be distributed in a computer-processable, non-proprietary form in a manner that meets best current practices for the distribution of open government data. That data should represent the definitive documents, not just aggregate, preliminary, or modified forms; 9) An active program of research and development should be sponsored by governmental bodies that issue primary legal materials to develop new standards and solutions to challenges presented by the electronic distribution of definitive primary legal materials. Examples include the automated detection and redaction of private personal information in documents; 10) An active program of education, training, and documentation should be undertaken to help governmental bodies that issue primary legal materials learn and use best current practices. After a lot of research on the functionality and the selection finally narrowed down to Flip UltraHD, Kodak Zi8 and Kodak Zx3, one last thing to look for was what kind of prices people were talking for these products. Big retailers like Amazon and others have their prices listed, but they are current prices. The question was, were there deals either currently happening or in the past for these items? That's when, they turned to twitter's own real-time search engine. However, searching for a product number brings back a lot of tweets that have no price information. Rather than scanning through all these tweets, they decided to create a custom search engine, using Twitter's excellent API, and provide searches that focus on showing tweets with prices in them. Further, along with the search term the prices available in these tweets are also highlighted. The interesting observation from looking at these filtered and highlighted tweets is that you can see that even in this internet age with real-time information flow, the prices of products vary a lot. Further, they realized that many of these tweets have various different critical information other than prices. For example, in addition to pricing, some of the tweets contained information about a) free shipping, b) no sales tax, c) refurbished, and d) time sensitive such as auctions. So, ptoogle looks for such useful information in these tweets and visually highlights them. Since most people narrow down their purchasing option to just a handful of products, they also want to provide them the ability to compare these pricing options across the products. Hence, ptoogle's user interface is designed to allow retaining the search results. That is, when a search is performed, the previous results are pushed down and the latest search results are displayed on top. There are also several options for each of the search results such as refreshing, removing, downloading as a csv file, a permalink to bookmark and even tweet the permalink to your friends. 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US Cropland Greenhouse Gas Calculator

About 6% of total greenhouse gas emissions in the US are associated with the agricultural sector. The three major greenhouse gases from agriculture are carbon dioxide (CO₂), nitrous oxide (N₂O) and methane (CH₄). Carbon dioxide is emitted through fossil fuel use on and off the farm (eg. vehicle use and fertilizer production). It can also be emitted or sequestered depending on the type of land and crop management practice used (eg tillage and residue management). Methane emissions predominate in animal agriculture, and are produced during enteric fermentation and through manure management. Nitrous oxide is the major greenhouse gas emitted from crop agriculture, primarily through soil management activities such as nitrogen fertilizer application. Quantifying all three of these greenhouse gases is necessary to determine the importance of farm mitigation options. By altering or adopting management practices, farmers have the potential to reduce their greenhouse gas footprint, and make a substantial contribution to mitigating climate change both regionally and at the global scale. To calculate the greenhouse gas impact of different crop rotations and varying management practices, begin by moving your cursor over the map and click on a county. The next screen will show an estimate of the greenhouse gas cost (CO₂ equivalents) of a 'baseline scenario' corn-soybean rotation in that county, based upon data from the USDA. To see how different management practices and farm conditions alter the greenhouse gas cost of the system, you can then change the crop, tillage type, fertilizer rate and environmental variables to create new scenarios. 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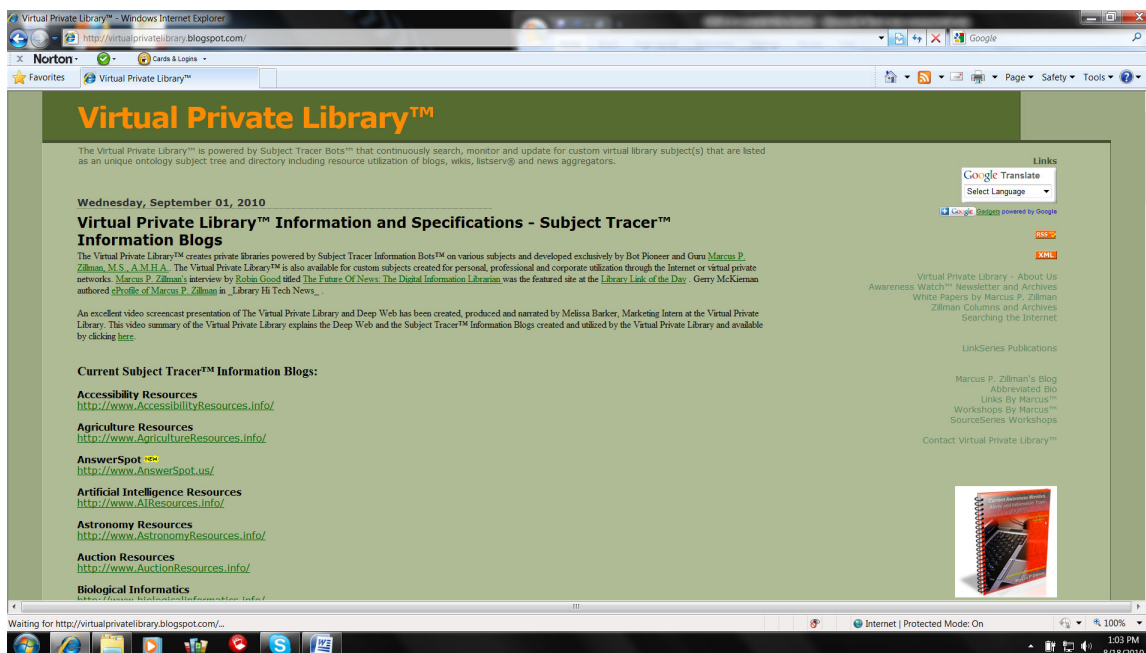


Figure 1: Virtual Private Library™
